<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>The project brought the possibility of preserving traditions in EU countries. We managed to transfer traditions to modern times and connect them with current topics related to events in the EU. As part of the project, we created a space for getting to know the cultural and linguistic diversity of the partners. We held a discussion on topics that the EU is currently addressing and the future of Europe. We supported getting to know each other between citizens of 4 European countries. We contributed to creating the future of the partnership. The selection of topics and elements that the project addressed is deliberate with respect to the partners' area of operation and the current needs of society. These are elements/topics that currently resonate. Their task is to connect people from different corners of Europe, transport European values among ordinary citizens, and involve citizens in solving the future</p>			

of Europe. We supported the fulfillment of the main project's goal: to create a space for connecting citizens through traditions, current events, and the future.

Activities:

The project activities were implemented during the 10-day event. The activities were grouped into 10 themes, which formed the main elements of each day. Activities were implemented in the following themes:

- Partnership – activities aimed at strengthening the partnership
- Cultural diversity – activities aimed at presenting the culture and cultural diversity of Europe
- Minorities – activities aimed at understanding minorities, especially the marginalized Roma minority
- Equal opportunities – activities aimed at implementing gender equality and equal opportunities for all age groups
- New European Bauhaus – activities aimed at presenting the most recent EU initiative and discussing current European issues
- Solidarity – activities aimed at supporting and helping others, providing inspiration to young people in helping the community
- Civic engagement – activities aimed at supporting citizens' involvement in public affairs at the local level and stimulating interest in volunteering
- Future of Europe – activities aimed at presenting the Europe we want
- Traditions – activities aimed at presenting traditions and supporting intercultural dialogue
- Connection – activities aimed at connecting citizens from different corners of Europe and the greater integration of partners within the partnership

Representatives of partners formed only handful of participants. Coordinator - Občianske združenie Novum Naswod was represented by 420 participants. Associated partners ensured participation: Szulok – 30 participants; Kiskőrös – 60 participants; Nagyigmánd – 30 participants; Asociata Kincsásó – 30 participants; Délibáb – 6 participants.
